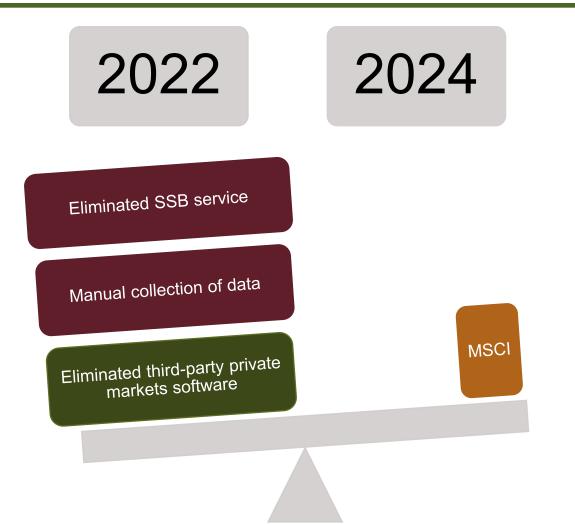
Overview

- Assists staff in overseeing and managing a complex portfolio
- Provides a total portfolio view that holistically views exposures across the entire portfolio (i.e., public and private)
- Critical infrastructure for an institutional portfolio
- Provides granular views within asset classes, including:
 - asset class level
 - underlying investment fund level
 - portfolio company level

Simplification of Systems



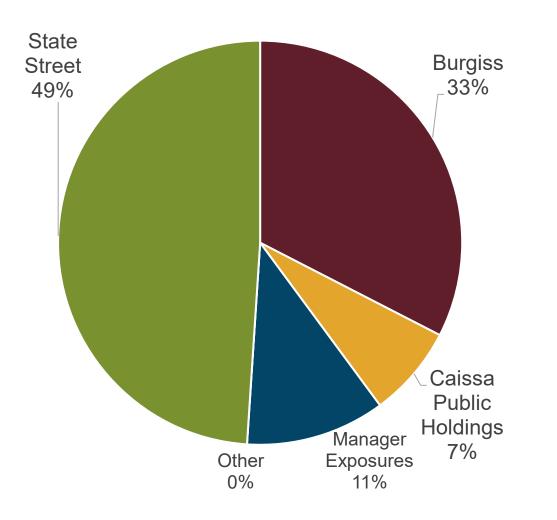




- Caissa merged with Burgiss in 2021, which was then subsequently acquired by MSCI in 2023, the gold standard in risk analytics
- Board approved contract in June 2022
- Onboarding took longer than expected but is almost entirely implemented (99%+)
- Now analyzing data to inform decisions

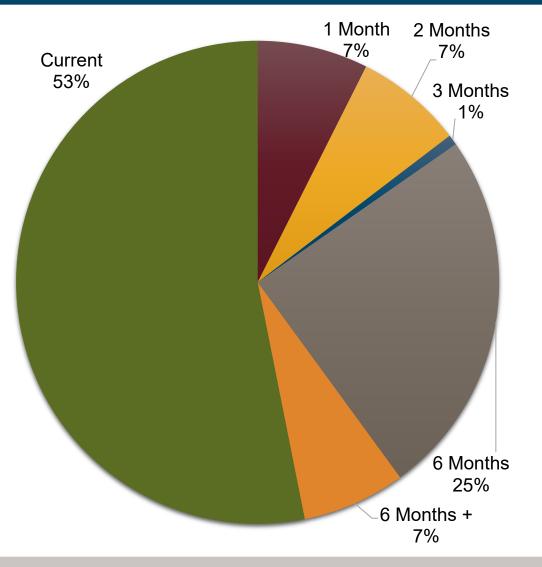


Source of Data



- Detailed holdings level information on 89% of the portfolio
- Exposure level information on 100% of the portfolio
- Information flowing into the system daily with 90%+ entered into Caissa within 72 hours of receipt
- Limited staff involvement

Timely View



- Majority of assets priced daily
- Given the number of private market funds in the portfolio and delayed reporting, 4-month-plus delay is expected
- Small number of funds being integrated into the system

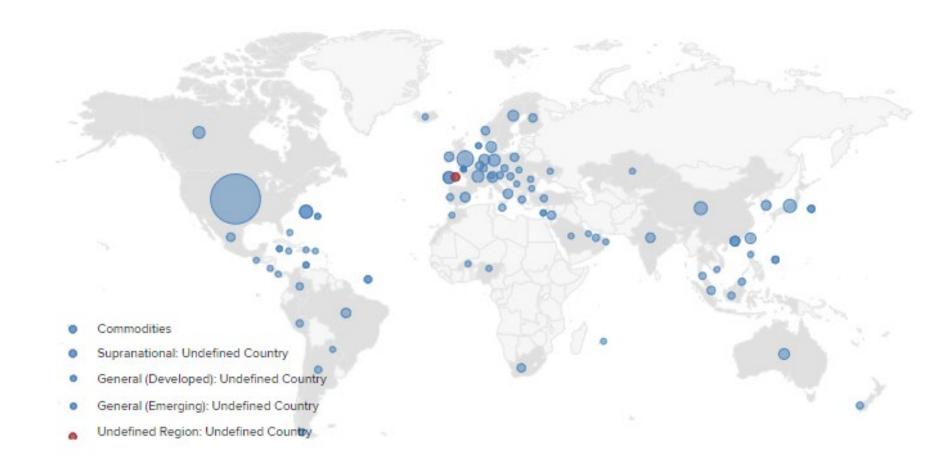

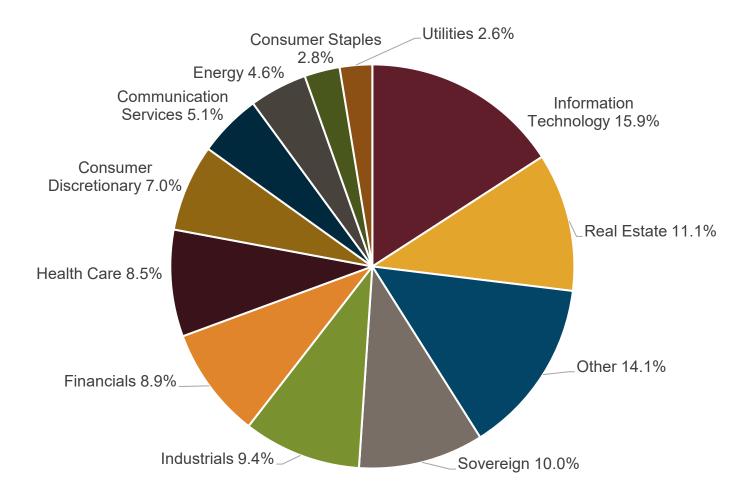
